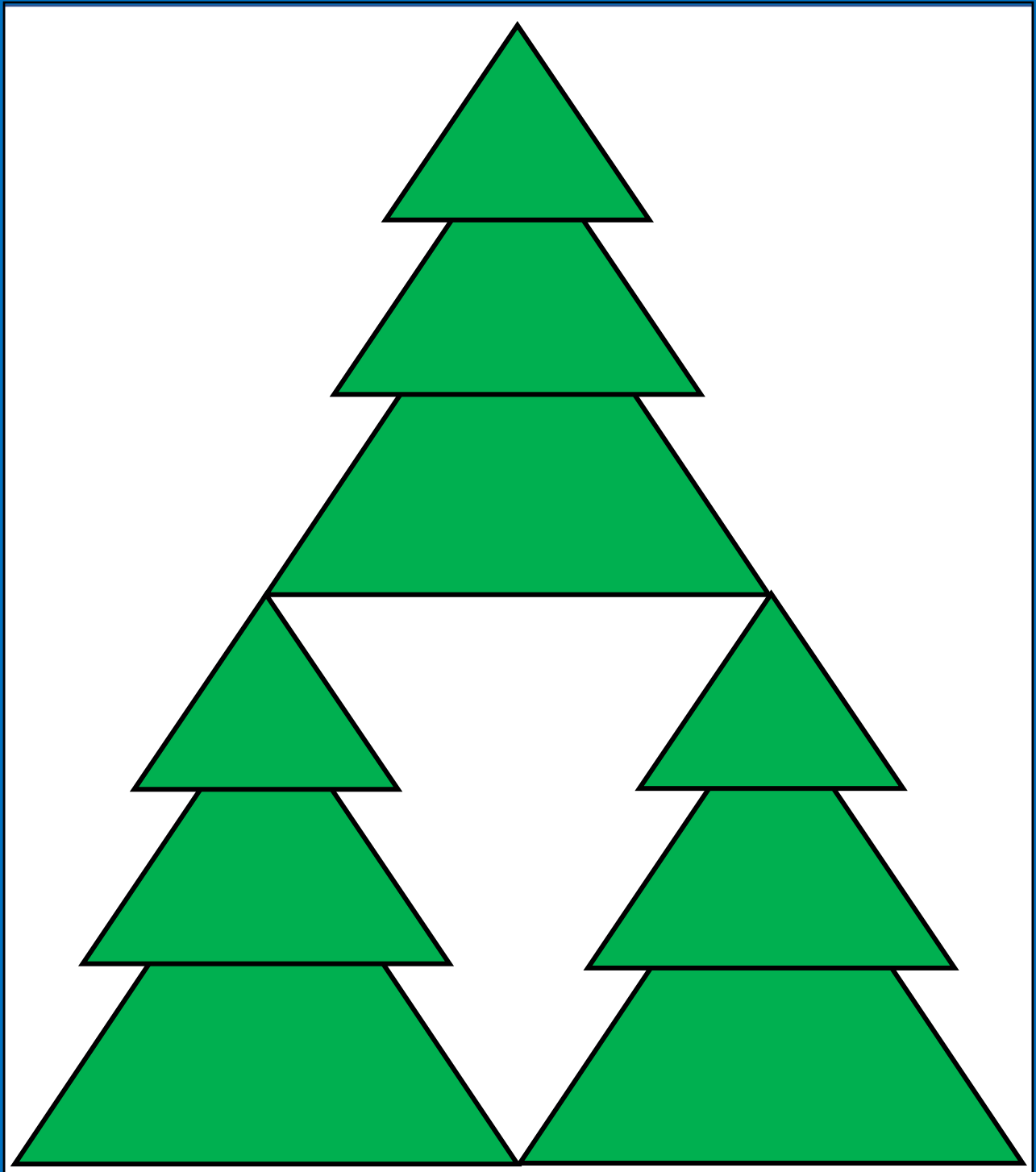
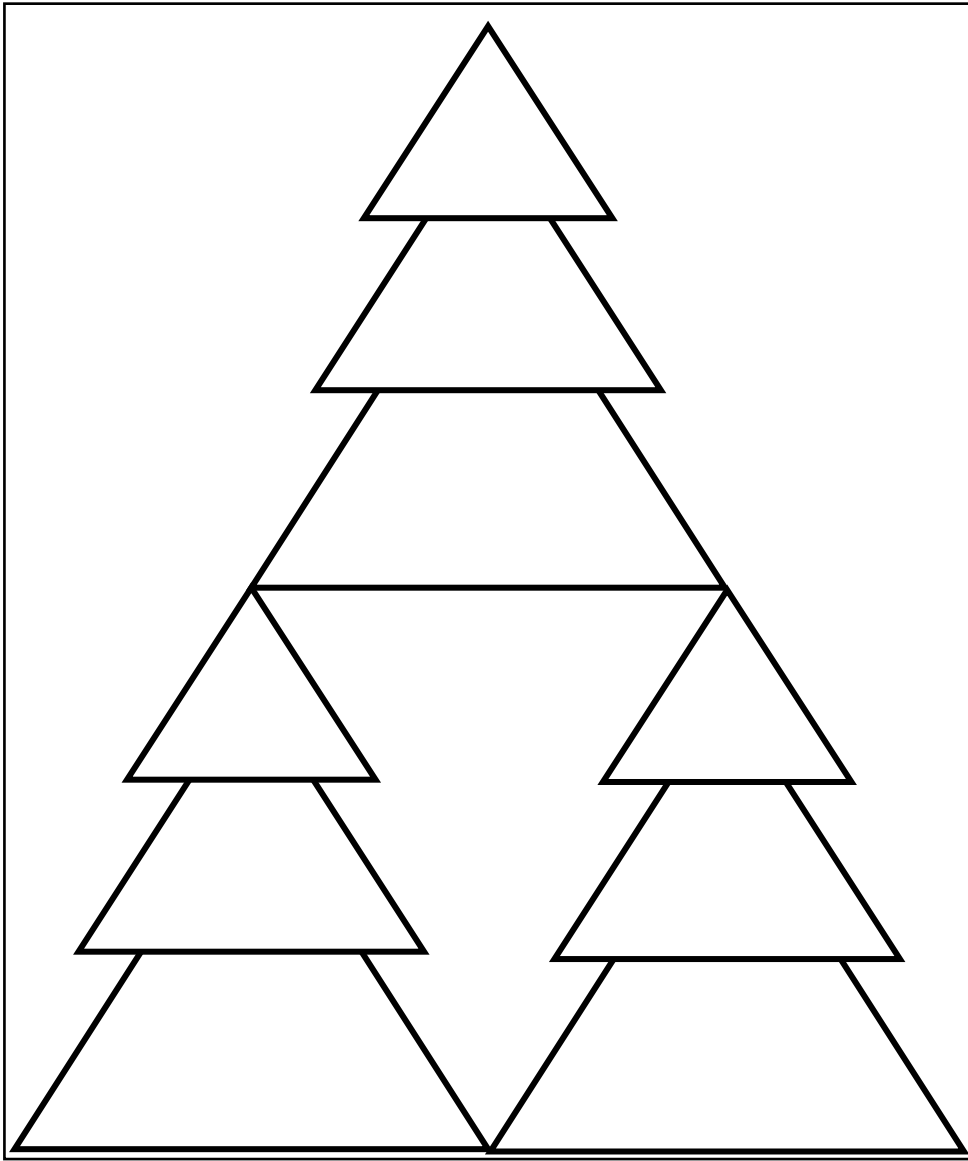

Directions Arranging the Trees:

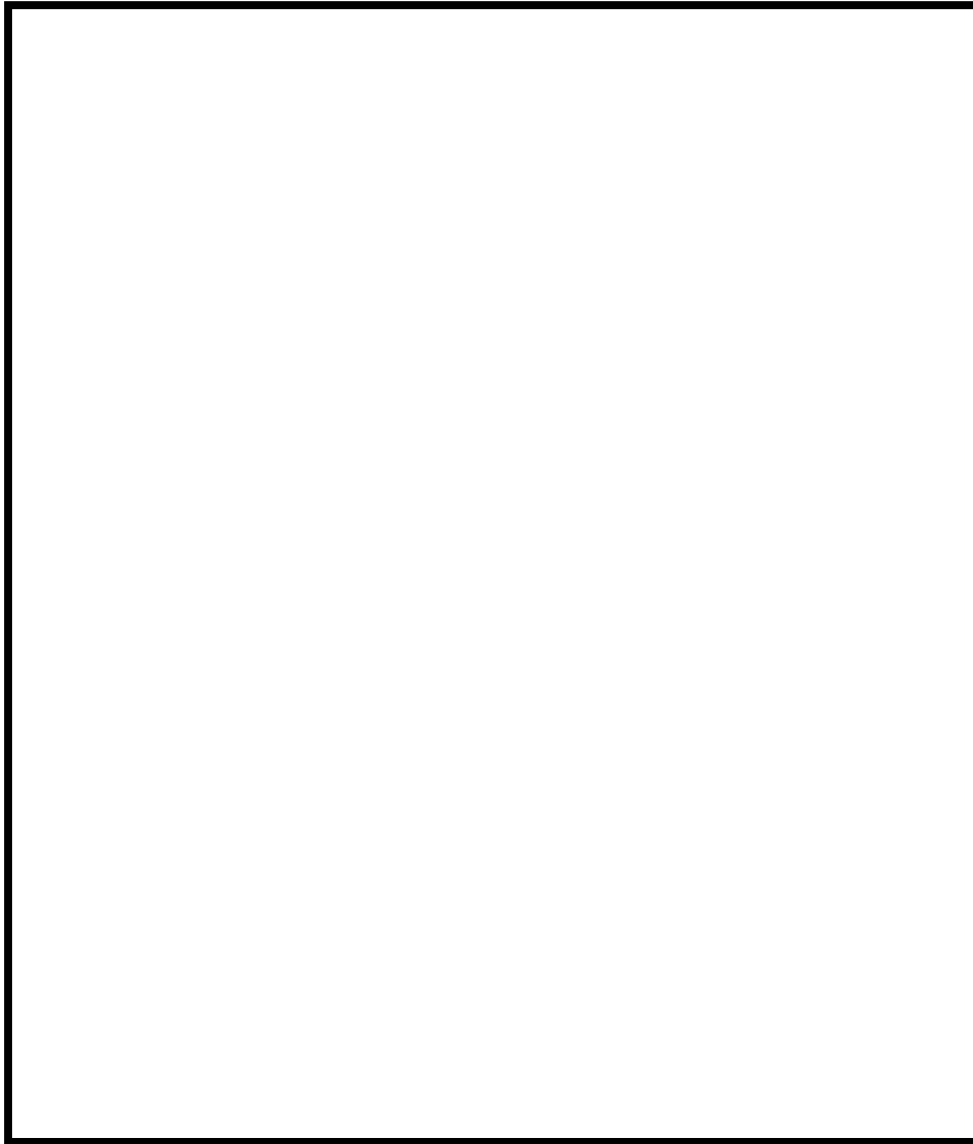
- Glue one tree right side up at the top of the box.

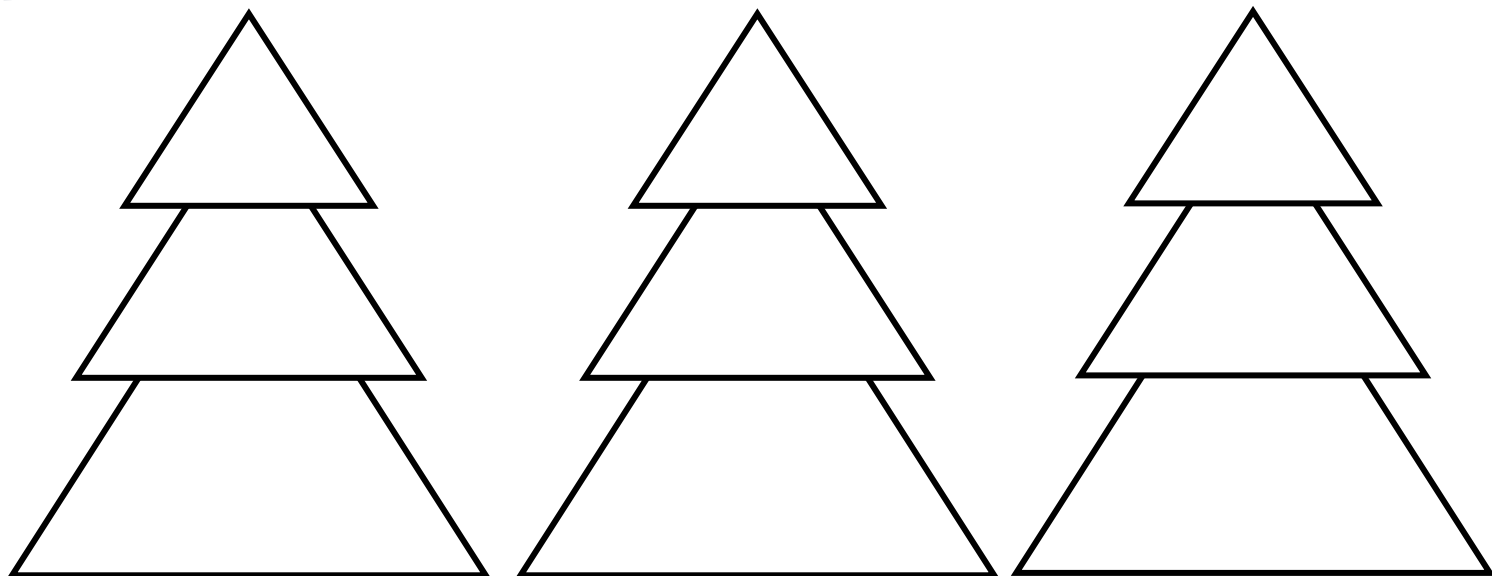
Christmas Tree Tessellation
