




How to Use This Set

- If your children aren't familiar with writing friendly letter, you may want to go over the parts of the letter diagram with them.
- Before they work on their own, you will need to share what you want them to include in the body of their letter.
- Next, you will want to go over the different closings they can use in their friendly letter. Some of them are used in standard letters. Others are used with people you love or are close to. Sincerely is not included on the letter closing list. While it is fine to close a letter with sincerely, I wanted children to know there are other ways to close a letter.
- Finally, children may need help in knowing how to sign their letter. Letters to people that they know may not need their formal first name or last name. Those letters may be signed with the name the person receiving the letter knows them by. Letters to people they don't know should include both their first and last name.
