Creating a Metamorphic Rock Themed Candy

You will use the recipe below to create a metamorphic rock candy and then describe what it looks like.

Supplies:

- 12 ounces of chocolate chips
- 12 ounces of white almond bark

Directions:

- Trace the bottom of a pan onto a piece of parchment paper.
- Cut out the shape you traced.
- Place paper inside the pan.
- Then place the chocolate chips into a microwave safe bowl.
- The white almond bark needs to go into a second microwave safe bowl too.
- Melt the bark and the chips in a microwave for 2 to 3 minutes.
- Stir both midway through that time.
- Stir the chocolate chips again and then pour the mixture into the pan.
- Pour the melted almond bark into the pan.
- Swirl the bark into the chocolate. Do not blend it in.
- Refrigerate the mixture until it is hard.

What is metamorphic rock?

It is a rock that has been changed due to chemical or physical changes from one type of rock to another.
