

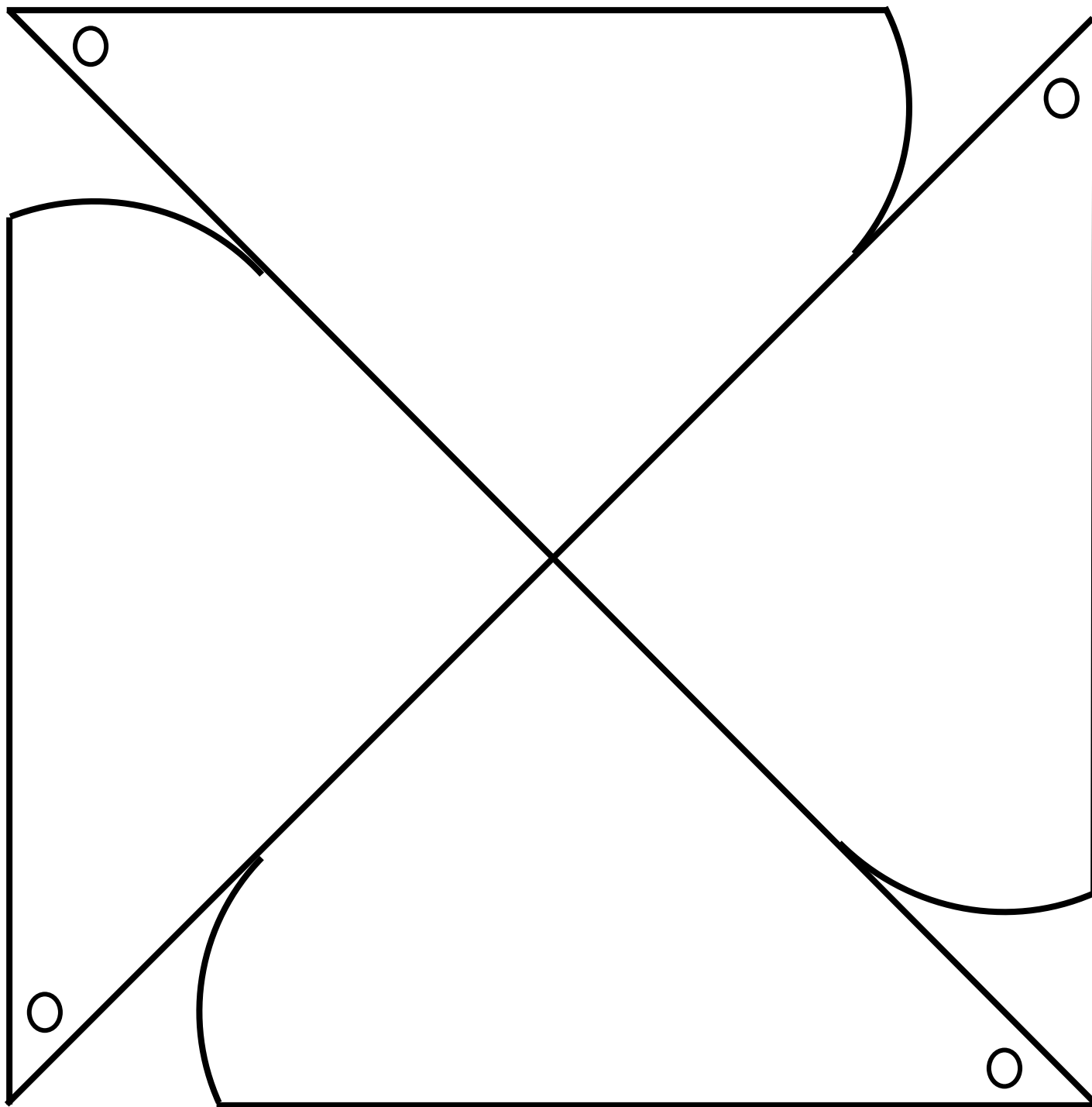
Poinsettia Pinwheel Template

How to Put the Poinsettia Pinwheel Together

1. Cut out the pinwheel shape.
2. Use a hole punch or pin to place a hole in each of the pointed ends.
3. Curl each point to the center of the pinwheel.
4. Glue a yellow circle in the center of the pinwheel.
5. Push a pin through the center of the pinwheel to hold all of the points in place.
6. Place a bead on the pin behind the pinwheel.
7. Push the pointed end of the pin through eraser end of a pencil. Then bend the pin and tape it down.
