




Directions for the Spider Parachute Challenge

- 1. Tape two straws to either side of your cup.
- 2. Tape the other ends of the straw to a coffee filter.

Attempt three parachute drops.


- 1. Keep the straws taped to your cup.
- 2. Tape the other ends of the straw to a cupcake liner.

Attempt three parachute drops.

- 1. Tape two popsicle sticks to either side of your cup.
- 2. Tape the other ends of the straw to a coffee filter.

Attempt three parachute drops.

- 1. Keep the popsicle sticks taped to your cup.
- 2. Tape the other ends of the straw to a cupcake liner.



How to Use This Activity Set

- You may want to go over the feelings displayed on the I Spy pages. You can do that by going through one of the sets of flashcards or going over the feeling displayed in the chart.
- Then you will want to have your children figure out how many of each candy corn face there is displayed on the page.
- Your children can write the number of faces found for each feeling with a number or a tally mark. There is one sheet for each way in the set.
- If you think your children will have trouble remembering that they have already counted a piece of candy corn you can have them color the candy corn as they count or put an x on them.
